EMPLOYEE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM INCLUDES:

1. Telephone or In-Person Counseling

Legacy's licensed and professional counselors listen and carefully evaluate employees' needs and offer short-term counseling focused on coping strategies. LTS professionals address areas such as marital difficulties, substance abuse, including alcohol or drug abuse, parenting and family conflicts, grief counseling, stress management, depression, emotional problems and much more. Employees in need of long-term counseling and specialized care are referred for the appropriate treatment plans.

2. Work-Life Services

These are resources offered to help employees with overwhelming challenges to find a healthy work-life balance.

3. Orientation and Kickoff Meetings

The LTS staff will coordinate with the employer and employees to schedule times that work best for everyone.

4. EAP Communication Material

Employees will receive a full range of print and electronic communications material to help educate and remind employees how to access services.
