Funeral planning assistance, including a funeral home locator, funeral coordination and educational resources.



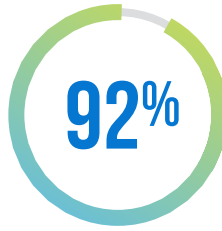
